If, after tabulation of the Judges' Record of Choice, two contestants receive the same placement point score total, the tie shall be broken by comparing the Record of Choice scores of five judges for the two contestants (note: circled numbers on illustration above). One of the contestants will be the winner over the other by a majority of the Judges' Record of Choice when only the placement of the tied contestants is considered. In the illustration above, Judge No. 2 scored Contestant No. 4 as 2 and Contestant No. 5 as 3. Based on those scores, it is considered that Judge No. 2 ranks Contestant No. 4 above No. 5. Using this procedure for all five Judges' Scorecards, the majority of the five judges will break the tie and determine the winner. In the illustration above, Contestant No. 4 is the winner even though Contestant No. 5 had two firsts and whose total points (which are not considered in a two-way tiebreaker) were greater than those of Contestant No. 4.
