Subject Alternate Uniform Cap

Referred to Convention Resolutions Committee

WHEREAS, Resolutions #58 in 1964 and #46 in 1965 established regulations for wearing The American Legion Cap, Uniform and Regalia; and

WHEREAS, Those Resolutions and regulations have served this organization well through the decades; and

WHEREAS, Through the years, the members' sense of style and comfort have evolved; and

WHEREAS, The traditional American Legion Cap is not always practical to wear when working or volunteering outdoors and at certain patriotic events; and

WHEREAS, The typical baseball cap is now the preferred hat by many men and women in the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Alternate Uniform Cap could be attractive, not only to younger members, but to all Legionnaires; and

WHEREAS, The National and Department Organizations could regulate and restrict the use of the Alternate Uniform Cap; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion, Department of New York in Convention assembled July 16, 17, 18, 2015 in Buffalo, NY that it request the National Organization to create an official Class B Uniform Cap that resembles our current uniform cap for use by members of The American Legion; and, be it finally

RESOLVED, That, if accepted, this resolution be forwarded to the National Organization in Convention assembled on September 1, 2, 3, 2015 in Baltimore, MD for their consideration and action.
