

NYS American Legion League rule concerning status of a new shooter;

Current 2016-2018 National Standard Three Position Air Rifle Rules Book, section 3.4.5 New Shooter Category .

Change adapted to NYS The American Legion League & State Championship concerning new shooter in the NYS American Legion League starting season of Sept. 1st, 2017- Feb. 28th, 2018, This rule is in effect till 2020.

New shooters **CAN'T HAVE** any shooting experience prior to the beginning of the NYS American Legion League & Championship to be eligible for **NEW SHOOTERS AWARDS** @ the NYS American Legion State Championship.

New shooters during the current NYS League season can fire in sanctioned & un-sanctioned matches outside the American Legion League during the current league season of their being first year shooters and still maintain their status as first year shooters.

Definition of New Shooter:

An individual that hasn't fired in any form of competition before which includes BB gun competition or training , 4-H, Boy Scouts , NRA, USA, JROTC, CMP, US Army, Orion, unofficial team practices or official team practices.

Hasn't been trained by coaches or other Team officials before joining the team.

Has very limited knowledge of shooting sports.

Definition of Season:

NYS American Legion League Season starts September 1st & Ends officially @ the end of the NYS League Championship per calendar year of the NYS American Legion League State Championship.
