

Post Consolidations

This section is aimed at County and District Leadership and membership officers

Posts may become “stale” and unresponsive, lose their vibrancy and therefore their membership.

County and District Leadership should review the membership numbers at year end (June) looking for posts with less than 15 members or posts which have not submitted election reports or consolidated reports.

County and District Leadership must contact the posts and advise them of the issue as above and assist them with a revite or post 1 members in their areas. If the post is unresponsive or if they are unable to grow into a viable post, members should be contacted about consolidation with another post or if they choose, transfer into Post 1. If it is determined that the post is no longer viable, ALL post members MUST be transferred out and post financials resolved so the post can be closed and charter turned in.
