Subject Korean War Recognition Day

Referred to Convention Resolutions Committee

WHEREAS, Many brave American military men and women served both in combat and support units to defend democracy in Korea, and

WHEREAS, According to the Department of Veterans Affairs in September 2009 there were 153,749 veterans who served during that specific era, and

WHEREAS, New York State has provided a statewide recognition to World War II Veterans, Vietnam Veterans, and those who have served during Desert Storm, and

WHEREAS, 482,000 New Yorkers fought in the Korean War, and

WHEREAS, New York has the fourth most Korean War Veterans in the country, and

WHEREAS, Our brave men and women helped preserve democracy and stopped the spread of Communism on the Korea peninsula, and

WHEREAS, Our Korean Veterans have not received the same recognition as other military veterans from WWII to Desert Storm in New York State, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Department of NY American Legion strongly urge the New York State Legislator and Governor to name April 26th as Korean War Recognition Day, and be it finally

RESOLVED, That the Department of New York American Legion encourage each county and municipality to devise appropriate recognition.


