# **Basis For The Evaluation Of Scouter Of The Year Nominations**

The presentation of information shall follow the outline below. **Nominations submitted** in any other format WILL NOT be considered. The Department of New York wishes to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions. Please note the emphasis on leadership. It is not necessary for the candidate to be a member of The American Legion. The candidate may be either male or female.

# IT IS NOT REQUIRED THAT THE NOMINEE BE A MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN LEGION, HOWEVER, THE NOMINEE MUST BE A MEMBER OF EITHER THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA OR THE GIRL SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

- 1. His/Her contributions as a leader in the Boy or Girl Scouting Program. Please provide:
  - a. Scout leadership positions, including dates and locations.
  - b. Details of major contributions, including dates and locations. This is especially important!
  - c. Scouting recognition received, including dates.
  - d. Information on contributions beyond the local council.
  - e. Include information about activities as a youth, if available. The more detail, the better. Remember general statements mean nothing.

#### TOTAL POINTS = 25

1. The nominee's contributions as a leader in the community. The definition of community is broad. It can include the local community, the county, area, or state. Provide the same information as requested for item 1.

## **TOTAL POINTS = 15**

2. The nominee's contributions as a leader to his/her religious community. Provide the same information as requested for item 1.

3. The nominee's contributions as a leader to youth outside Scouting programs.

American Legion Scouting and youth programs are to be included here. Provide the same information as requested for item 1.
