


# Department of New York American Legion High School Oratorical Scholarship Program "A Constitutional Speech Contest"

2024 - 2025





#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Eligible participants in The American Legion High School Oratorical Scholarship Program – "A Constitutional Speech Contest" shall be citizens of or lawful permanent residents of the United States.

All contestants must be bonafide students herein described as any student under the age of twenty (20) years on the date of the National Finals Contest and who is presently enrolled in high school or junior high school (public, military, private, or parochial, or who are home schooled) in which the curriculum is of high school grade level commencing with grade nine (9) and terminating with grade twelve (12). Students must be enrolled in high school or junior high school during the time of participation at any level of the contest. High school students that graduate early during the school year are eligible to compete if they are not enrolled in a college, university, trade school or other institution of higher learning at the time of the Department finals contest. Contestants must either be legally domiciled within or attend an educational institution within the department (state) where they enter competition. Contestants can enter competitions in only one department (state).

#### **CERTIFICATION**

The Contestant Application (Form # 1) must be filled out and signed by the contestant, the principal of the high school, and parent or guardian. Both the Prepared Oration and Contestant Application (Form # 1) must be submitted to the County Chairman no later than November 23, 2024.

# **DATES OF CONTESTS**

County contests will be held between December 1, 2024, to December 30, 2024. Please contact your County Chairman to find out the date of your contest. District contests are held between January 4, 2025, to January 25, 2025, and Zone contests are held between February 1, 2025 to February 15, 2025. The dates of each level of competition are determined by the respective Chairmen. They will contact you once they have received your Contestant Application (Form # 1) and your Prepared Oration. The Department (State) Finals will be held on March 8, 2025, with a cancellation date of March 15, 2025, at 9:30 AM, at the Crown Plaza-Desmond Hotel, Albany, New York. All Contestants and Chaperones must be in Albany by 4:00 PM March 7, 2025.

The National Finals are May 17 and 18, 2025 at Hillsdale College, Hillsdale, Michigan. All contestants must be at the contest site on May 16, 2025. The National Organization will bear the expenses for the contestant and their chaperone. See www.legion.org for additional information.

#### **CONTEST FORMAT**

New York is broken down into four levels of competition, County, District, Zone, and Department (State) Final. Each school may enter three (3) contestants in the County Contest. Preliminary County Contest maybe run if too many contestants enter prior to the County Final. Each District will structure their contest to conform to the number of contestants that have applied to compete in the County contests, and how many will advance into the District contest or contests. **No County or District will have more than six contestants in any preliminary or final contests without the consent of the Department of New York Chairman.** The District Chairman will report the first and second place winners to the Zone Chairman. Two contestants from the District contest will continue to the Zone contest, and then one contestant will go on to the Department (State) Final. There will be five contestants in the Department (State) Final of which one will go on to the National Finals.

Department Scholarship Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Place \$6,000.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$4,000.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$2,500.00; 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Place. \$2,000.00

National Scholarship Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Round each contestant receives \$2,000.00 Scholarship.

\$2,000.00 Scholarship
