50-75 will receive a Gold Recruiter Membership Pin with a Ruby Stone
76 and above will receive a Gold Membership Recruiter Pin with an Emerald Stone

Department Commander Membership Incentive Pin

Department Commander John R. Miga will award his Department Commander pin to any Legion Family member who recruits three new members for the 2026 membership year into the American Legion – two of the three **MUST** be Legion members to qualify.

Top Ten Membership Award

To each individual within their Post that has enrolled 10 or more NEW MEMBERS into The American Legion by **Department Convention Call**. Each Post with a qualifying individual will receive a plaque upon which each qualifying individual will have their name engraved. Each qualifying individual will also receive a polo shirt.

DEPARTMENT POST AWARDS:

The awards are based on the Posts, which as of the dates listed below, have the greatest percentage over their 2026 membership goal. PUFL Posts and Posts with less than 15 members will not qualify.

Post Membership Achievement Award

All Post Membership Chairmen that reach 105% of their membership goal by December 31, 2025 will receive a citation. In addition, their names will be entered into a drawing to receive one of three cash awards of \$100.00 each. **Any Post without a Membership Chairman on file will not be eligible**, drawing to be held at Mid-Winter Conference.

A.L. Birthday Citation

A citation will be awarded to all Posts whose membership as of March 4, 2026 exceeds their total 2025 membership achieved prior to the start of the 2026 membership year.

Department Honor Ribbons

Honor ribbons will be awarded to all Posts that achieve 105% of their 2026 membership goal by Department Convention Call.

Post Membership Citation

All Posts that achieve 125% or more of their 2026 membership goal by Department Convention Call will receive a \$25.00 gift certificate to National Emblem Sales.

All Posts that achieve 105% or more of their 2026 membership goal by Department Convention Call will be placed in a drawing which will be held at Department Convention.

First Prize winner will be awarded \$300.00

Second Prize winner will be awarded \$200.00

Third Prize winner will be awarded \$100.00

DEPARTMENT COUNTY AWARDS:

The awards are based on the Counties which have the greatest percentage over their 2026 membership goal. They must have 100% or more of their 2026 goal to qualify.

County Membership Citation

A Membership Team medal will be awarded to the County Commander and County Membership Chairman who achieve 100% or more of their 2026 membership goal by Department Convention Call.

DEPARTMENT DISTRICT AWARDS:

The awards are based on the Districts which have the greatest percentage over their 2026 membership goal. They must have 100% or more of their 2026 goal to qualify.

District Membership Citation

A Membership Team medal will be awarded to the District Commander and District Vice Commander who achieve 100% or more of their 2026 membership goal by Department Convention Call.

ELIGIBILITY

The Let Everyone Get Involved in Opportunities for National Service Act of 2019 – The LEGION Act – offers American Legion membership eligibility to any U.S. military Veteran who served at least one day of active military duty since Dec. 7, 1941 and was honorably discharged or is serving now.

You are also eligible for membership if:

- Your basic training time was on federal activation orders and during the above period.
- You were federally activated subsequent to and during the period given above.
- Your activations were for training or for missions; check the title and subsection of your activation orders.

Under eligibility guidelines for Legion membership, the term "active duty" as used in our national constitution includes "active duty for training."

However, our guideline further defines National Guardsmen and reservists as eligible under services to federal activation orders Title 10, Subsection 672 or Subsection 12301, created following Desert Storm to replace Subsection 672. In other words, to determine eligibility for service members in the National Guard or reserves, the activation order is the authority line. Non-eligible activation orders are Title 32 for the National Guard and Title 10 Subsection 270 for the reserves.

Space Force

Per Title 36 of the US Code, Chapter 217, Section 21703,

An individual is eligible for membership in the corporation [The American Legion] only if the individual—

(1) has served in the Armed Forces of—

(A) the United States at any time during—

(i) the period from April 6, 1917, through November 11, 1918; or

(ii) any time after December 7, 1941; or

(B) a government associated with the United States during a period or time referred to in subclause (A) of this clause and was a citizen of the United States when the individual entered that service; and

(2) was honorably discharged or separated from that service or continues to serve honorably during or after that period or time.

The United States Space Force was created by the National Defense Authorization Act of 2020, signed by the President on December 20, 2019. It became Public Law No: 116-92,

“§9081. The United States Space Force

“(a) ESTABLISHMENT. — There is established a United States Space Force as an armed force within the Department of the Air Force....

(c) SPACE FORCE AS AN ARMED FORCE. — Section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code, is amended by inserting “Space Force,” after “Marine Corps,”.

Thus, as amended, Section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code reads:

(4) The term “armed forces” means the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, and Coast Guard.

Therefore, as title 10 of the United States Code now includes Space Force as an “Armed Force” and our federally chartered membership criteria uses the same wording [“has served in the Armed Forces.... any time after December 7, 1941”] there are no necessary acts required to extend membership to all who have served or continue to serve in the United States Space Force.
